

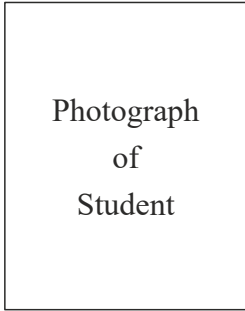

Dear parents,

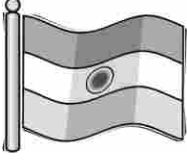

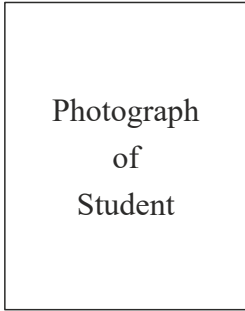

## **OUR VISION OF SCHOOL EDUCATION**

We consider schools a powerful agent in forming fully alive human beings to bring about a just society. The School's aim at creating individuals who are intellectually competent, morally sound, psychologically whole, imbued with the sense of the divine, committed to the cause of justice, love and peace, and ever open to further growth. The school aspires towards creating a human society, free from prejudice, superstitions and discrimination based on sex, religion, caste and economic status, and characterized by respect for the dignity of the human person, leading to concern for each other especially the underprivileged. For the attainment of this goal, we expect parents and teachers to share this vision and to co-operate in making it a reality.

Our vision of education is based on the conviction that education has a unique role to play in man's integral growth as well as in the society's development and reconstruction.

## **ADMISSION**

Although Catholic Minority Schools are meant primarily for Catholics, they may also admit other children irrespective of caste, creed and religion as per the availability of the seats.

## **GENERAL RULES**

1. Strict regularity, implicit obedience, courtesy in speech and conduct, cleanliness of dress and person are expected from every pupil. Pupils must strictly conform to the regulations laid down in this regard.
2. The pupils are responsible to the School authorities not only for their conduct in the school but also for their general behaviour outside. Any reported objectionable conduct out of the school on the part of the pupils make them liable for disciplinary action.

3. The wearing of the school uniform is obligatory. Violation of this is a sufficient reason for the expulsion of a student from the school. No student will be allowed to the school without the prescribed uniform.
4. No student should possess mobile phone, CD, Pen drive or any other electronic items and jewellery or valuables whatsoever in the school campus, the school shall not be responsible if these are lost or stolen.
5. No collection for any purpose, whatsoever, is to be made without the prior permission of the Principal.
6. Presents to the members on the staff in cash or any kind not allowed.
7. **The date of birth of a student once entered will not be changed. The Parent/ Guardian will have to sign an undertaking to this effect.**
8. **The name of a student who does not rejoin within three days after the commencement of a term shall be struck off the rolls unless leave has been previously applied for and the sanction obtained from the head of the institution.**

*Note:*

This rule does not prevent the Principal from refusing admission to the new session for adequate reasons to a student who was on the rolls in the previous session.

9. Children must speak English in the school campus.
10. All pupils must possess a copy of the school diary, which is to be brought on all working days.
11. Late comers and absentees from school will not be admitted to the class without the Principal's written permission.
12. Every student is expected to be on time daily for the assembly with the school diary at the commencement of the first meeting.

13. School gate will be closed with the first bell for safety reasons. The entry thereafter will be restricted.
14. No leave of absense is granted, except on written application from parent and that only for serious reasons. The school accepts no responsibility, if a child is obliged to return home during school hours for non- compliance of any of the rules contained in this calendar. Mere sending of an application is not sufficient; the sanction of leave must be obtained.
15. The pupils are not allowed to visit the Staff Room.
16. Fine may be imposed by the Principal for irregularity, or damage to the school property.
17. The pupils are not allowed to leave the school premises during the school hours.
18. The school authorities may exercise their right of not readmitting the students who fail to return within three days after the vacations.
19. Parents and guardians are, therefore, particularly requested to co-operate with the school authorities by sending their children back to the school on the re-opening date unless a written permission for extension of the leave has previously been obtained. Such permission, however, will only be granted for very grave reasons.
20. In case of illness, a medical certificate must be produced within three days of absense of the student. The school accepts the medical certificates of doctors in the government service, not below the rank of chief physician or surgron only. In case of doubt, the school may insist on the child being examined by the civil surgeon or the school doctor.
21. If a student continues to be absent for a month, without the previous written permission of the Principal, his/her name

will be struck off the roll, and in case of his/her rejoining, the re-admission fee will be charged.

22. a) Irregular attendance, frequent failure to obtain good in conduct, habitual lack of interest and prolonged or intermittent illness, behaviour detrimental to the discipline and the moral tone of the school, repeated failure in tests or examinations and insubordination are sufficient reasons, singly or together, to expel a student guilty of such laxity or misdemeanour, even without any notice of warning.  
b) On national days like Republic Day, Independence Day and any other notified school function every student has to be present without fail. Absence on such days will be considered very grave and anti-nationalistic.
23. The school authorities do not hold themselves responsible for the student's loss of money, books, in articles of clothing etc. The students are expected to look after their own belongings.
24. Articles found in the school are to be handed over to the Principal's Office.
25. Parents are strictly forbidden to interview their children or their teachers in the class, without the permission of the Principal. Open Day (PTM) only when they can meet the teacher.
26. Students should not be taken away from the class by anybody without an application from the parent or guardian.
27. a) The Principal may punish a student in a manner suited to the offence e.g. by detention after school hours or by expulsion from the institution for any reason.  
b) The Principal reserves the right to waive aside any of the rules contained in this prospectus /calendar for valid reasons.

- c) The interpretation of any rule in the prospectus rests solely and entirely with the governing body and management committee of this school. Their interpretation and decision is final.
  - d) For disobedience to the clear expressed orders of the Principal, punishment laid down is dismissal without any previous warning. The same punishment is laid down for moral turpitude, writing on the walls and roads and defiance of the authorities.
28. No pupil of less than 3 yrs. as on Jan 1 of the year of admission and more than 4 years will be admitted to Class Nursery. For the higher classes add one year for each class.
  29. No pupil will be admitted without transfer certificate from the last school attended and in no case shall a scholar be permitted to attend a class pending formal admission.
  30. If a pupil comes from an unrecognized school or other District/State/UT, his/her admission can be had only after the inspector of schools countersigns the transfer certificates.
  31. The leaving certificate of a pupil coming from a school outside Uttar Pradesh State must be countersigned by the Educational Authorities of the district, in which the school is situated. Please send the leaving certificate in good time to the Principal of the former school, for the counter-signature, as this is required to finalise admission.
  32. A pupil joining school for the first time must produce satisfactory evidence the date of birth, such as an extract from the Municipal or Village records or Baptismal certificate. Date of Birth once registered cannot be altered (UPGO No. 1101/1(5)).

33. Pupils applying for admission are as a rule subjected to a test. In the case of late admission of a pupil, the fee from the beginning of the first term shall be charged, unless otherwise ordered by the Principal.
34. When the pupil is admitted on a transfer certificate he shall not be placed in any class higher than that for which the certificate shows him to be qualified, will he be promoted before the end of the school year.
35. Every application for a leaving certificate shall be made in writing by the parent or guardian.
36. A leaving certificate will not be issued until all the fees are paid.
37. A transfer certificate will be issued only 3 days after receipt of an application. Any certificate from the school can be provided if an application is made to this effect three days in advance.
38. A month's notice in writing is required before a pupil can be withdrawn. In lieu of such a notice, a full additional month's fee will be charged. No notice is accepted during the school vacation and in case of a withdrawal at this time, the fees must be paid upto the end of the term.
39. The school neck-ties, and monograms to be worn by every pupil except Nursery, LKG & UKG.
40. Students who are dirty in dress, or without uniform will not be permitted to sit in the class.
41. If a pupil is obliged to come to school without the proper uniform, he/she should get a note of satisfactory explanation from his/her parents otherwise he/she will not be admitted to class.

### **COURSE OF STUDIES AND EXAMINATION**

42. Course of studies includes Moral Science, English, English Literature, Hindi, Sanskrit, History and Culture

of India, Geography, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Geometry, Computer Science, Accountancy, Economics, Business Studies, Informatics Practices, Art, Physical Education, Handicraft, S.U.P.W., Env. Studies and many other curricular activities.

43. No pupil is allowed to offer any subject which is not regularly taught in the school, or provided for in this approved scheme of studies.
44. The reports will be shown to the parents or guardians after the examinations.
45. Students absent from an examinations for any reason will not be re-examined.
46. a) Wilful breach of the regulation for the conduct of the examination is punishable by expulsion from the examination hall and subsequently leading to the cancellation of the paper.  
b) Candidates who are detected in giving or obtaining or attempting to give or obtain unfair assistance or who otherwise are detected in any dishonesty whatsoever will be prevented from the examination to subsequent papers or expelled from the school.
47. Reports will be withheld for non-payment of school dues. Absence from a subject excludes a student from being reckoned in the order of merit in the examination.
48. If a student does not have 75% attendance for the year he/she will not be considered for promotion.
49. For promotion, a student has to obtain clear pass 33% in major subjects.
50. A student who fails shall forfeit for the ensuing years any concession in the fees, and may even be advised to leave the school particularly, if his/her conduct has not been satisfactory in the school. If a student fails twice, he/she will have to leave the institution.

### **FEES RULES**

51. All are encouraged to pay fee online/D.D./NEFT,
52. The parents are requested keep the receipts issued to them and produce them as proof of payment, if needed.
53. The fees must be paid for months, during which pupil has been absent during these months.
54. The fees for the term must be paid in full, even if the pupil leave before the term is over.
55. No reduction of fees is made on account of mid- summer and winter holidays or other vacations or temporary absence.
56. The children whose school fees fall into arrears are liable to be debarred from taking the terminal tests, and attending school, till the fees are paid. Neither the reports nor transfer certificates will be issued, till all accounts are fully settled.

### **RULES OF THE LIBRARY**

57. The student must maintain silence in the library.
58. Every student will hold one card which is not transferable. A book is issued for one week, but within a week, the student should return the book otherwise a fine is levied.
59. Duplicate card will only be issued on a payment of Rs. 5/-
60. Every student should return the card before the session ends.
61. A book can be re-issued only twice.
62. Every class has a day on which the books will be issued. It is compulsory for every student to read books from library.

63. Students can return the book during library period and students who want to borrow a book should fill up the entries on their cards and leave them with the librarian. They can collect the book from the library during the library period. There will be an overdue charge of Rs. 1/- per day per book, if a book is kept longer than the specified period.
64. The loss or damage to the book will be realized along with a special fine.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS**

65. Parents of students are expected to give the management and the staff their whole-hearted and willing co-operation in all matters pertaining to the education of their children. Therefore:
  - a) Kindly abide by the judgement and decision of the management and the staff.
  - b) Lend your support in matters of discipline and see that your children observe school rules.
  - c) Supervise your children's studies at home, send them to school regularly and help to maintain continuity in their school work. It is essential for success.
66. Parents are informed that occasional reports and recommendations from teachers are made in the school diary. They are requested to sign them as proof that they have read them.
67. Parents are particularly expected to sign the terminal report or any other similar document, when so required.
68. Recommendations made by the Parent Teacher Association and accepted by the Principal will not be separately communicated to the Parents. Complaints, if any, should be made in writing to the Principal and not to the class teacher.

69. Students and parents are not allowed to engage any of the Staff members of the school for private tuitions. Students who engage teachers of the school for private tuitions are liable to disciplinary action even to the extent of expulsion from the school.
70. In matter of evaluating and estimating examination answers, as well as decision with respect to tuitions are liable to disciplinary action even to the extent of expulsion from the school.
71. Parents must understand that they cannot dictate to sill the management and that the management has a right bas to admit or retain pupils in their school.
72. No pupils will be allowed be absent from games and physical activities without a written note from a doctor which is to be renewed every two months.
73. Follow the traffic rules: Your little help can save precious life: Do extend your co-operation.
74. Kindly ensure that the vehicle which is used for conveyance of your children has all the required documents and is in good condition (fitness) and the driver is experienced with a valid licence.
75. No pupil will be allowed to use two wheelers without valid licence. Use of bicycles will be highly encouraged.

## NATIONAL ANTHEM

The song Jana-gana-mana, composed originally in Bengali by Rabindranath Tagore, was adopted in its Hindi version by the Constituent Assembly as the national anthem of India on 24 January 1950. It was first sung on 27 December, 1911 at the Calcutta Session of the Indian National Congress. The complete song consists of five stanzas. The first stanza contains the full version of the National Anthem.

**Jana-gana-mana-adhinayaka, jaya he  
Bharata-bhagya-vidhata.  
Punjab-Sindh-Gujrat-Maratha

Playing time of the full version of the national anthem is approximately 52 seconds. A short version consisting of first and last lines of the stanza (playing time approximately 20 seconds) is also played on certain occasions. The following is Tagore's English rendering of the anthem.

**Thou art the ruler of the minds of all people, dispenser of India's destiny. Thy name rouses the hearts of Punjab, Sind, Gujarat and Maratha, of the Dravida and Orissa and Bengal; It echoes in the hills of the Vindyas and Himalayas, mingles in the music of Jamuna and Ganges and is chanted by the waves of the Indian sea. They pray for thy blessings and sing thy praise. The saving of all people waits in thy hand, thou dispenser of India's destiny. Victory, victory, victory to thee.**

## The Indian National Song VANDE MATRAM

The song Vande Matram, composed in Sanskrit by Bankim Chandra Chatterji, was a source of inspiration to the people in their struggle for freedom. The first political occasion when it was sung was the 1896 session of the Indian National Congress. The song first appeared in his book 'Anandmatha', published in 1882 amid fears of a ban by the British Raj, though the song itself was actually written six years prior in 1876.
